Inscription on the arbitrators list of the Swiss Commission of Arbitration

The ICC Swiss Commission of Arbitration and ADR is an arbitration body of the Swiss national committee of ICC (ICC Switzerland). Its function is to search sole arbitrators or chairpersons of arbitral tribunals when ICC Switzerland is invited to make a proposal to the ICC International Court of Arbitration (Art. 13/3 ICC Rules). In order to fulfill this mission, the Swiss Commission of Arbitration has established a list of Swiss arbitrators.

The admission criteria are:

- The applicants must have Swiss citizenship or the main business address in Switzerland.
- Sufficient experience in arbitration proceedings, particularly under the ICC Rules, must be shown. This is generally the case if the applicant has not only participated as counsel in ICC proceedings, but has also served as member of the arbitral tribunal (ideally in two or more ICC proceedings).
- Each applicant has to be recommended by two experienced arbitrators, external of his or her law firm, who are prepared to certify that the applicant is able to conduct an ICC arbitration under his/her own responsibility.
